



The Exhibitor / Sponsor may only present on his/ her stand or space the materials that are relevant and described in the application to participate.

Transfer or sub-letting of all or part of the allocated space or session is prohibited. Exhibitor/ Sponsor is not allowed to advertise on behalf of firms not exhibiting.

Obligations and Rights of the Organiser

The Organisers reserve the right to change or offer new packages as the congress planning develops. They will honour the pricing of those packages where appropriate completed booking forms were received and acknowledged earlier.

In case of absolute necessity and/or for reasons beyond their control, the Organisers retain the right to change the Venue without prior notification.

The Organiser also reserves the right, in case of absolute necessity to modify the positioning of the exhibition booths with no obligations to provide compensation to the Exhibitors / Sponsors.

The Organiser reserves the sole right to decide who will be admitted and to which areas and at what times.

The 21st International Congress for Tropical Medicine and Malaria (ICTMM 2024) conjointly with 60th MSPTM Annual Scientific Conference (MSPTM 2024) and 10th ASEAN Congress of Tropical Medicine and Parasitology (10th ACTMP) will be held from 19th to 23rd September 2024 as a physical conference. During this period, neither exhibitors / sponsors or their agents may conduct or sponsor any educational, marketing or media activities directed towards the Organisers' event participants other than as part of the event scientific programme as acknowledged and approved by the Organiser or as specifically authorised by the Organisers.

The use of the Organiser's name or the name of the event can only be used by Exhibitor / Sponsors for promotional materials related to the event only with the written approval by the Organisers.

Liability Insurance for Physical Exhibitors / Sponsors

All equipment and related display materials installed by the Exhibitors / Sponsors are not insured by the Organiser. The Organiser under no circumstances will be liable for any loss, damage or destruction caused to equipment, goods or property belonging to Exhibitors / Sponsors. The Exhibitor / Sponsor is responsible for their own property and person and for the property and persons of his / her employees and agents and for any third party visiting his space. The Exhibitor / Sponsor agrees to purchase sufficient insurance policies to cover any claims in relation to events described hereof including those usually covered by fire and in general indemnify the Organisers from such claims.

Exhibition Regulations for Physical Exhibitors / Sponsors

Detailed regulations and guidelines concerning the exhibition will be presented in the Exhibitor Technical Manual. Participation by Exhibitor / Sponsor is dependent upon compliance with all rules, regulations and guidelines stated herein.

All exhibits must avoid blocking aisles, obstructing adjoining booths, damaging the premises or the leased equipment. Exhibitors are requested to allow sufficient see through areas which ensures clear views of surrounding exhibits. Any panels, posters or other forms of display are not allowed outside of the exhibition area allocated to the Exhibitor.

Any special booth designs or decorations or fittings must be submitted to the Organiser's appointed contractor 30 days before the Exhibition date for prior approval.

If the Exhibitor decides to provide refreshments for the participants, this is permitted only if the catering regulations of the venue are observed.

Exhibitors are responsible for the cost and execution of the design, installation and delivery of their display and its' removal from the exhibition site at the allocated standard booths. Flammable materials are not to be used. Equipment displayed must be installed with strict adherence to safety measures. Exhibitors must adhere to the timetable designated for the completion of their display before the exhibition opening and it's dismantling at the close of the exhibition. No dismantling or packing of the display before the designated hour for close of the exhibition. It is the Exhibitors' responsibility to pack and remove all items of value prior to leaving their exhibit unattended, otherwise the Organiser will arrange for their removal at the Exhibitor's risk and expenses.

Exhibitor is responsible for the cleaning of their own space. The Organiser will ensure daily cleaning of the aisles.

For security reasons and to adhere to regulations stipulated by the venue, the Organisers will appoint official contractors for all installations (such as electricity, communications, hanging points, mains and fittings) and all ancillary services. During setup and dismantling periods, as well as the actual exhibition, no other contractors will be permitted to undertake any of this work without the prior consent of the Organisers.

The Exhibitors / Sponsors will be liable for any damage to walls, floors or ceiling of the venue by screws, nails or paint of any other cause whatsoever. The Exhibitor guarantees to pay for the repair of any damage caused.

When planning activities, the Exhibitor / Sponsor shall respect the overall scientific programme of the Conference. Therefore, if the Organisers consider any activities a disturbance or not in line with the rules and regulations, the Exhibitor / Sponsor agrees to cease such activities immediately.

Storage space is not guaranteed to be available in the exhibition hall. The Exhibitor must ensure that all packaging materials, including empty boxes, are removed from the premises prior to the opening of the exhibition. The Organisers reserve the right to order cleaning of an Exhibitor's space at the cost to the Exhibitor.

Payment

Payments must be completed within the stated period and before the Exhibition starts. All orders will be confirmed upon receipt of the payment.

If payment is not received in due time, the Exhibitor's / Sponsor's participation will not be considered or cancelled. It is the Exhibitor's / Sponsor's responsibility to advise the Organisers of any problems with any orders and to check the invoices issued for accuracy.

If more Exhibition / Sponsorship items are added onto the original order, the additional amount due shall be paid immediately.

Payments must be made by bank transfer. Bank charges must be paid by the transmitter and are the responsibility of the payer. Please use the bank account noted in the sponsorship and/or invoice and/or Exhibitor Manual respectively.

Should the Exhibitor's / Sponsor's payment be delayed, the Organisers reserve the right to charge interest for the delay.

Cancellation

The Exhibitor / Sponsor shall notify the Organisers of any and all booking cancellations in writing. The Exhibitor / Sponsor shall assume responsibility for all costs payable for all terms that are part of the booking. The Organisers shall be reimbursed for all expenses in connection with the planning of the conference incurred up to the date of termination and any foreseeable unavoidable costs that might result from the Exhibitor's / Sponsor's cancellation or from the Exhibitor's / Sponsor's commitment. The following cancellation charges apply:-

- i. Any cancellations to sponsorship packages or exhibition booths must be in writing. 50% of the total amount committed must be paid by the Exhibitor / Sponsor if the cancellation notice is received before the 30th June 2024.
- ii. Any cancellations received on or after the 1st July 2024 will not be accepted and the sponsor will be required to pay the full amount invoiced.

Shall the Exhibitor / Sponsor fail to appear at the congress and the requested services are no longer required, the Exhibitor / Sponsor will still be obliged to pay the amounts referred to in the cancellation policies.

Should the Exhibitor / Sponsor desire to offer its space and/ or sponsorship items for re-sale to another Organisation, this can only be done after the approval of the new Exhibitor / Sponsor by the Organisers. After approval, the original Exhibitor / Sponsor must pay a 10% administrative charge.

The Organisers are entitled to cancel the conference due to reasons beyond their control that prevent or substantially hinder the planned holding of the conference.

If the Organisers are compelled to cancel the Conference for reasons beyond their control ie. without organising another conference in its place within 12 months of the original planned date, the Exhibitor / Sponsor is released from its sponsorship obligation. The Organisers shall refund 50% of the payment made by the Exhibitor / Sponsor within 8 weeks after the decision is officially announced. The remainder shall be used by the Organisers for payment of costs incurred.

The Organisers reserve the right to re-schedule the conference either as a conference or as multiple smaller events. In this case, the Exhibitor/Sponsor does not have the right to withdraw from or decrease its sponsorship participation.

Governing Laws

This booking is made and shall be governed under Malaysian law. Exclusive jurisdiction and venue of any actions arising out of, or relating to or in any way connected to this booking, its negotiations or termination or the event will be in the courts of Malaysia.

Amendments / General Supervision

All exhibition / sponsorship matters and questions not covered by these Terms and Conditions are subject to the decision of the Organisers. These Terms and Conditions may be amended from time to time by the Organisers and all amendments shall be equally binding on all parties. In the event that any amendment or additional to these Terms and Conditions, written notice will be given to the Exhibitors / Sponsors if they are affected.
